

Our speaker this year was the Honorable Jennifer O'Mara, Pennsylvania State Representative for the 165<sup>th</sup> House District, which includes the townships of Springfield, Marple, Radnor and the borough of Morton. Ms. O'Mara is the youngest State Representative and only the second woman to represent the district. She spoke frankly about her past and how it shaped her decision to run for election.
